Each person has the potential to change the world, but working along with others is often the most efficient way.

- If churches or other like-minded people band together, companies are more likely to respond. "There's strength in numbers. If you're a parish with 600 families, and a parish council paying the bills, you might send out a letter...telling a utility company you want them to reduce emissions," says energy consultant Michael Mangan.
- Ernesto Cortes, Jr., is a regional director of the Industrial Areas Foundation, a national network of community organizations which has founded citizens groups from lowa to California. He has helped create jobs through the promotion of water and sewage treatment facilities for the Rio Grande Valley.
- Mountain climber David Brower, who died at age 88, believed that "We need to try to save the Earth at least as fast as it's being destroyed." He worked for decades on behalf of environmental organizations.

Robert Cox, the Sierra Club's president, said: "Like the...redwoods he cherished, David towered above the environmental movement and inspired us to protect our planet."

- Over the years, the Adkins Road dump, one of many "holler dumps" in beautiful Appalachia, became an eyesore. Karen Engle, director of a grassroots environmental group in Kentucky, decided to clean up the area. She mobilized others. TV cameras will monitor the site to discourage illegal dumping.
- Noted chimpanzee researcher and activist Jane Goodall began Roots and Shoots in Africa. Now a worldwide club, it encourages children to work on environmental and humanitarian projects.
